	Confirm water delivery systems are able to provide adequate water for public consumption; boil water advisory status is acceptable Confirm garbage collection and/or treatment system are functional at minimal acceptable level Confirm power is restored to provide essential levels of service Confirm road systems are safe and usable Confirm sewer and/or septic systems are safe and usable
STA	AGE 3 – COMMUNITY RE-ENTRY
	Confirm the nature of the threat no longer exists and that a partial or complete evacuation rescind for re-entry has been issued ☐ Consider recommendations from response and support agencies ☐ Consider restoration of critical infrastructure such as power, water, transportation routes and other utilities that are important to support ☐ Rapid Damage Assessment results have identified properties safe to re-enter ☐ Placards posted on doors ☐ Confirm community recovery activities are safe to be conducted
